

**ORDINANCE 2002-185**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND PROHIBITING SIGNS WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY IN THE BOROUGH OF MILLSTONE, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Millstone, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. No sign shall be placed by any person within any public right-of-way within the Borough of Millstone. Additionally, no signs shall be placed on any property owned by the Borough of Millstone unless authorization is received from the appropriate officials of the Borough of Millstone. Also, no sign shall be placed on the property owned by the County of Somerset or the State of New Jersey unless authorization is received from officials of the Borough and the appropriate State or County officials. This prohibition shall not apply to signs placed on behalf of or by any political subdivision of the State of New Jersey. Nor shall this prohibition apply to temporary signs placed in connection with construction on a right-of-way or made necessary because of said construction.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with New Jersey laws.

Section 3. Any other ordinance of the Borough of Millstone dealing with the subject matter of this ordinance be and is hereby amended and modified as set forth herein and to the extent that any other ordinance is inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, such prior inconsistent ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
