RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE GRACE PERIOD FOR 2ND QUARTER 2020 TAX COLLECTION

WHEREAS, the 2020 second quarter tax bills are due on May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, due to the Covid-19 pandemic Governor Murphy has issued Executive Order 130 authorizing municipalities to extend the grace period for tax collections until no later than June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Millstone recognizes the financial strain the current circumstances have placed on many residents of the Borough and desires to provide relief in accordance with executive Order 130 in the form of a waiver interest on delinquent 2020 second quarter tax installment payments provided such payment are made in full on or before June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 54:4-67(a)(1) authorizes municipalities to fix the rate of interest for nonpayment of taxes, assessments and other municipal liens or charges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Millstone, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that (1) the waiver of interest on delinquent 2020 second quarter tax installment payments is here authorized provide such payment are made on or before June 1, 2020; and (2) any 2020 second quarter tax installment payments received after June 1, 2020 shall be subject to the interest calculated from May 1, 2020.
